



Australia's Shane O'Neill Secures the Lead Position Heading into Pro Street Semifinals On Day Two of Dew Tour Long Beach 2017

Eight Amateurs also Move on to Bowl Finals with 15-year-old Roman Pabich Leading the Pack

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June 16, 2017 (*Long Beach, Calif.*) — The second day of the 2017 Dew Tour Skateboard Competition and Festival presented by Mountain Dew® and TEN: The Enthusiast Network was firing today with skaters vying it out in Pro Street Qualifiers and head-to-head competition in the Am Bowl Semifinals. The weather was Southern California perfection -- bright sunny skies and a light breeze -- and skateboarders from around the world went in all or nothing for a shot at making it to this weekend's finals.

During Pro Street Qualifiers, 24 skaters rallied the tech, gap and rail sections working to get the highest overall score, with the 11 top athletes from today advancing to Sunday's semifinals. In the end, only six coveted spots will move on to finals and close out the event Sunday evening. Getting one step closer to the Dew Tour title was 27-year-old Australian Shane O'Neill ending in the top position, scoring a 267.00 out of 300. Orange County's Nyjah Huston, came in close behind with a total score of 260.60, while Yuto Horigome from Japan secured third with 249.20 points.

The Am Bowl Semifinals also went down today with Roman Pabich from Ocean City, Mich. rallying the hardest and earning the top spot in Saturday's final, with a score of an 82.00 out of possible 100.00. The only non-American amateur, Keegan Palmer from Australia, placed second with 80.20 points, and CJ Collins from Victorville, Calif. finished third with 77.00. A total of eight amateurs will compete in the Bowl finals, whittled down from an original field of 46.

The weekend is set to go off with the Pro Team Challenge Finals and Am Bowl Finals tomorrow, and Am and Pro Street Finals and Pro Bowl Finals to conclude the event on Sunday. Tomorrow night, Metro Boomin, Cam'ron and Amine will play a FREE outdoor concert in Rainbow Lagoon starting at 7 p.m. Dew Tour Long Beach is FREE and open to the public from 11 a.m. - 6 p.m through Sunday.
